WORKSHEET II: WINTER FEED AND FORAGE SUPPLIES And WORKSHEET IV: FALL FEED AND FORAGE SUPPLIES Explanation and Guidance

Working with Worksheet I: Feed and Forage Supply, copy onto Worksheet II each entry that will provide WINTER feed or forage (shown in purple on the example sheets) to any group of your cattle and onto Worksheet IV each entry that will provide FALL feed or forage (shown in orange on the example sheets) to any group of your cattle. For FALL here we are using the period from weaning until you begin your wintering program. Of course, you can assign any time frame that fits your operation. Some of you will also need to include your horses and other livestock, but here we will concentrate on cattle.

Here is the reason you separated into different Ref. Codes, the different products provided by a single field. If Ref. Code B2 defines fall grazing for field B and Ref. Code B1 defines hay from field B, you will enter B1 and its information onto Worksheet II, and you will enter B2 and its information onto Worksheet IV. It is probably easiest to work with both Worksheet II and Worksheet IV at the same time. Enter every Ref. Code and its information that will provide winter feed or forage or supplement onto Worksheet II, and enter every Ref. Code and its information that will provide fall feed or forage or supplement onto Worksheet IV.

NOTE: No row lines are pre-drawn on the worksheets so you can use all the space you need to enter data. To keep order, you might want to draw a line under each completed entry so it will be easier to keep them separate.
