OSU Steer-a-Year Presentation | Matt Kennedy, OSU

The Steer-A-Year program was started in 1993 by Dr. Bill Zollinger, Dr. Kelvin Koong and Dr. Dale Weber. It was originally taught as a class to teach students about the beef feedlot industry through hands-on instruction of small group of cattle with focus on animal health, nutrition, carcass grading and beef marketing. In the fall of 2008, it was transitioned to a club based activity to help grow the impact of the program to students outside the Animal Science department to students of all majors and backgrounds. It still has a classroom aspect as students can take it for credit and go more in-depth into their knowledge of the beef industry. Currently the program is led by 8 student officers with positions include program manager to public relations to marketing. These officers that help direct the efforts of an average 30 students from term to term in the care of the cattle and efforts of the program. There is currently 21 head of cattle in the barn that originate from all across Oregon and Northern California. The students are advised by Matt Kennedy and Melissa Millhollin.
