Oregon By The Numbers:

Oregon's cattle inventory totaled **1.24 million head** in 2023.²

Cattle and calves ranked **#2** in Oregon's agricultural cash receipts in 2021. ⁴

Cash receipts in Oregon for cattle and calves totaled **\$839.7 million** in 2021. ⁴

Of the 37,616 farms and ranches in Oregon, **84.2%** were owned by individuals or single families.³

15.1% of all cash receipts in Oregon agriculture in 2021 was cattle and calves. ⁴
