

Post-fire resources for eastern Oregon livestock and agricultural producers

For immediate assistance associated with livestock, forage, and crop losses contact your county's **USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) office**. Available programs:

- **Livestock Indemnity Program (LIP)** - payments to eligible producers for livestock death losses in excess of normal mortality due to adverse weather.
- **Livestock Forage Disaster Program (LFP)** - reimbursement for some monthly feed costs when livestock have been excluded from federal grazing allotments due to fire/burned area rehabilitation closures.
- **Emergency Assistance for Livestock, Honeybees, and Farm-Raised Fish Program (ELAP)** - emergency relief for losses due to feed or water shortages, disease, adverse weather, or other conditions, which are not adequately addressed by other disaster programs.
- **Emergency Conservation Program (ECP)** - emergency funding to rehabilitate land severely damaged by natural disasters; cost-share assistance may include pipelines, tanks, restoring permanent fencing.
- **Non-Insured Crop Disaster Assistance Program** - financial assistance to producers of non-insurable crops when low yields, loss of inventory, or prevented planting occur due to natural disasters including excessive wind and qualifying drought (includes native grass for grazing).
- **Tree Assistance Program** - cost-share assistance to replant or rehabilitate trees, bushes, and vines lost during a natural disaster.
